Huge congratulations to Phia Damsma, owner of Sonokids and Winner of our 2012 Professional Award. Phia has been awarded a technology development grant to become an 'AMP Tomorrow Maker'.

From more than 5000 applicants across Australia, 47 projects were selected for a personal grant & the judges selected Phia's work, which aims to improve computer technology skills in young children who are blind, for equal opportunities.



Phia's grant will be used to expand Sonokids' existing Ballyland educational software for PC into a complete educational program. This will be done through creation of new resources, such as accessible interactive iBooks & an accessible App for iPad.

"The whole purpose of this technology is to enable young children who are blind to learn & play together with other children, with or without a disability".
